The following information is to provide a summary of County activities for October 2018. Further explanations or details can be obtained by contacting the County Administration Office at 403.882.3211.

**Organizational Meeting** - Council held their Organizational Meeting on October 24, 2018. Stan Schulmeister was re-elected Reeve and Doreen Blumhagen was re-elected Deputy Reeve. Maurice Wiart was re-elected Chairman and Stan Schulmeister was re-elected, Vice Chairman of the Agricultural Service Board. The listing of Council appointments is available on the County Website.

**Public Hearing/Bylaws** – a Public Hearing was held on October 2, 2018 at 1:15 p.m. for the following Bylaws: Bylaw 663-18 – IDP Paintearth/Provost, Bylaw 664-18 – ICF Paintearth/Provost, Bylaw 665-18 – ICF Paintearth/Coronation, Bylaw 666-18 – IDP Paintearth/Coronation, Bylaw 667-18 – IDP Paintearth/Castor and Bylaw 668-18 – ICF Paintearth/Castor. Upon completion of the Public Hearing, the Bylaws received second, third and final reading at the reconvened Council Meeting.

**Draft Policy 575 Communications, Media Relations, Social Media** - MOVED by Councillor Blumhagen to accept the Draft Policy 575 Communications, Media Relations, Social Media to replace the previous Social Media Policy 565.

**RFD: Red Deer River Watershed Charter** – MOVED by Councillor Glazier the County sign the Charter for Protecting Source Water Quality in the Red Deer River Watershed submitted by the Red Deer River Watershed Users Group.

**Potluck Invitation – Brad & Verna Korturbash Family** - MOVED by Councillor Glazier that Administration assemble a package for the silent auction in support of the fundraiser being held for the Korturbash Family.

**Bylaw 669-18 – Code of Conduct** – A Bylaw 669-18 to establish the Code of Conduct regarding the conduct of Council, Council Committees, Members of Council Committees and other bodies established by Council was given first to third and final reading.

**RFD: Agricultural Service Board Structure** – MOVED by Councillor Blumhagen that two County Members at Large be appointed to the Agricultural Service Board for a one year term.

**RFD: 3 Point Disc** - MOVED by Councillor Glazier the County purchase a new Frontier 3 Point Disc from John Deere at \$6,350.00 with the addition of scrapers at \$1,148.00.

**RFD: Council Committees/Appointments** – MOVED by Councillor Norton the revised Council Committees/Appointments be adopted as amended and dated October 16, 2018.

**Letter of Support – Flagstaff County** – MOVED by Councillor Glazier the County send a letter of support for the CARES Funding Application from Flagstaff County for a Flagstaff Region Economic Development Five-year Strategic Plan.

**Letter of Support – Battle River Research Group** – MOVED by Councillor Blumhagen the County send a letter of support for the Battle River Research Group's Canola Agronomic Research Program.

**Reclamation of Ditch** – MOVED by Councillor Blumhagen to extend the deadline for reclamation of the ditch along Rge Rd 100 of SE 24-37-10 W4 to November 15, 2018.

**RFD: Pedestrian Signage** – MOVED by Councillor Wiart the County install pedestrian signage on the east side of the beach hill road going into the town of Castor.

**Town of Castor Fire Department** – MOVED by Councillor Hewitt the County provide \$50,000.00 to the Town of Castor Fire Department, for the Castor Fire Hall upgrades, funded from restricted surplus.

**Propane Tanks**

All sites can be used to recycle propane tanks. All sizes as well as the small camping tanks are accepted. The propane tank must be empty of any product and the valve must be in the opened position. The Attendant will check the tank and let you know where it is to be placed.

**Railway Right-of-Way**

There are still people using the old railway right-of-way for recreation purposes. The right-of-way is a utility corridor and contains important and valuable infrastructure that must be protected from any damage. We ask people to not use the right-of-way for recreational purposes.

**Site Safety**

It is very important when you are using any of the transfer stations to make sure you follow the speed limits as posted and always use caution when placing your recyclables or garbage in bins or designated locations. Watch for other traffic and people on site. Please stay on the designated roadways when not dropping off materials and do not cut across green spaces.
