APPLICATION / PAYMENT:

- √ Agreement must be completed and signed before keys are given.
- √ Any damages/cleaning fees to the facility will be charged back to the renter.
- √ Cheques should be made payable to the County of Paintearth.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY:

- ✓ The RENTER will carry their own personal liability insurance required for their event and name the County of Paintearth as coinsured on that policy;
- ✓ The RENTER will sign a waiver and shall assume all liability relating to the event and agrees to hold County of Paintearth exempt from any and all claims.
- ✓ County of Paintearth will not be held responsible for any manner of loss or damage that may occur to property or persons during the RENTER/S event.
- √ The RENTER is responsible for all their materials and should take adequate security measures at their own discretion.
- ✓ The consumption of alcohol is only permitted in accordance with the liquor laws of the Province of Alberta on County of Paintearth grounds; users must provide a copy of Host Liability Insurance.
- ✓ County of Paintearth may, at its sole discretion require user groups to have present at their event, safety or other specialized equipment or medical or security personnel.
- ✓ Events oriented to minors must be adequately chaperoned by one or more responsible adults who will assume responsibility for meeting the terms of the County of Paintearth user policies.

DAMAGES:

- ✓ If the RENTER causes damages to the County of Paintearth facilities, County of Paintearth will assess the damages and the RENTER will be responsible for all costs of the repairs.
- ✓ County of Paintearth will invoice the RENTER for the cost of damages and the RENTER hereby agrees to pay that amount upon receipt of an itemized list of the damages and their cost to repair.

GROUNDS/FACILITIES:

- ✓ The RENTER, at the conclusion of the event must leave all facilities used in clean condition. If any additional cleaning is required a charge will apply and is at the discretion of the County of Paintearth.
- ✓ Section #38 of the Public Health Act Food Regulation will be adhered to; animals are prohibited in establishments where food is prepared, stored or offered for sale, this does not apply to a guide dog used by a person who is hearing or vision impaired.
- √ No smoking within the facilities.
- √ The renter must abide by the facility occupancy loads
- ✓ No open fires permitted on grounds. Fire Pits only.
- ✓ Illegal or dangerous activities that are potential risks for property damage are prohibited on County of Paintearth grounds.
- ✓ All grounds accessories ie: garbage cans used during the event must be returned to its original location upon completion of the activity.
- √ Keys will be returned at the end of the post-function inspection.
- ✓ Renter or appointed individual locking up is to check the building to ensure all doors are secure, all lights are turned off and no fire hazards remain.
