Nomination period

The nomination period for the 2025 municipal election opens January 1, 2025, and closes at 12:00 noon on Monday, September 22, 2025. During this period, nomination papers can be submitted at the main administration office Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.

In order for the nomination papers to be accepted, they must:

Be complete and in the prescribed forms, include a minimum number of signatures from electors eligible to vote in the 2025 municipal election and be a resident within the local jurisdiction on the date of signing.

Requests for meetings and submitting nomination packages to the returning officer can be made by appointment only.

More details will be released over the coming days and months with important information regarding changes to the local authority elections act that impact you as a voter in the 2025 municipal election.

Information about advance polls will be made available closer to the election date.
